## Exhibition Proposal Guidelines

*Showcase your art!*

The French Art Colony serves as a catalyst for art, culture, art education, and community engagement. To be considered for an exhibition, artists must submit the following items:

### 2. Artist's Details

### 3. Submission Details

- Proposal: A clear concise description of your proposed exhibition and its rational.

\*Special Needs: If necessary, provide an explanation of any special installation, equipment, etc. and your plans to provide funding should extra equipment be required.

### 4. Visual Material

- Sample representation of work (photos/CD of jpegs/slides)
- All images are to be numbered to correspond to an image list with title, dimensions, media and price for each piece
  - Please view your material before submitting to ensure its readability on PC and MAC.

#### **5. Entry Fee**

- There is no entry fee to apply!

The FAC galleries can hold 25-50 pieces of 2-dimensional art, depending upon the finished size. 3-dimensional shows vary, depending on the size of the pieces and available display boxes. All 2-dimensional work must be framed and wired for hanging. No frames will be accepted with tab or sawtooth hangers.

The FAC Exhibit Committee reserves the right to determine independent or group exhibits, based on submission, artistic merit and/or showability. Artwork is displayed for approximately one month. Any preference for show dates should be listed in your proposal. Keep in mind the FAC encompasses multi-art opportunities, and merging creative stimuli into your show proposal (writing, music, etc.) is welcome.
